Journey from Frac Sand Mining . . .

Wisconsin now has 70 frac sand mines in operation. Permits have been issued for 140 more ranging from the beautiful **Driftless Area** to **Bad River** in the pristine **Penokee Hills**. Wisconsin is fast becoming the frac sand mining capital of the world with 60 % of our state being shipped out tax-free!

The world's largest open-pit iron ore mine, proposed near the shores of the **Lake Superior**, is poised to destroy the largest fresh-water system on earth – **Our Great Lakes!**

Mines pollute, leaving water unsafe to drink and fish unsafe to eat. Breweries will no longer tap underground aquifers. Tourists will cease to come. The economy will suffer.

Mines largely employ workers from out-of-state, some offering only 35 jobs per mine. Is it really worth it?
